

This coordinated transfer arrangement is intended to provide a structured pathway through which an eligible student may satisfy the academic requirements necessary to be awarded a degree from Stillman College (BS in Interdisciplinary Studies) and a Bachelor's of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree from Faulkner University.

I. Course Equivalency: As identified in this agreement, certain courses taken at a Participating College will be awarded hour-for-hour transfer credit if transferring to Faulkner University to complete a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree.

2. Faulkner Resources: Faulkner will provide opportunities for Stillman students who are enrolled in a Designated Program to become a part of the Faulkner campus community before transferring and through campus visits and special activities. These students will be eligible to receive a Faulkner student ID card, with instructions and conditions for its use, which provides access to Faulkner services, such as the following: Athletic events, Library use, and Career Services.

3. Academic Growth Opportunities: Students at Stillman College enrolled in the Designated Program will be added to an email group through which students will receive information concerning opportunities to serve as standardized patients for CHS programs, regular updates from the Department of Nursing, and learning opportunities that are typically extended to Faulkner's own lower-division nursing students. Students must complete Faulkner's "Intent to Transfer" form at the beginning of the 4th semester of the Plan of Study.

4. Guaranteed seat in the Faulkner BSN program: Students seeking admission under this provision must meet all admission requirements, selection criteria, and program prerequisites established by Faulkner University's Nursing Program. Faulkner will reserve up to fourteen (14) seats in its Upper Division Nursing Program each academic semester for qualified students from Stillman. Reservation of seats does not guarantee admission; all applicants remain subject to standard admissions review and approval processes. Students must have successfully completed all lower-division BSN prerequisites and who have an cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale after the completion of all prerequisite coursework.

5. Reverse Transfer: Students will be eligible for reverse transfer when they have met the following criteria:

- a) Transferred from Stillman to Faulkner.
- b) Earned at least 30 semester credit hours from Stillman.
- c) Earned at least 62 semester credit hours from Faulkner.
- d) Maintained good standing at both Stillman and Faulkner.

*The number of seats available in each BSN cohort is limited and acceptance is subject to availability. Qualified students will be admitted according to the submission date of their Faulkner application and an official transcript showing cumulative GPA.
